Dear Brandon Christensen:

The Division of Child Care has received your completed attestation to provide the following training to child care providers in Colorado:

- First Aid
- CPR
- Wilderness First Aid
- Universal Precautions

The First Aid and CPR training shall be conducted in accordance with the most recent American Heart Association's Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC Guidelines that are updated every 5 years, most recently in 2010) and shall focus on infants, toddlers and children. The instruction time this training shall require is a minimum of 2 hours each for first aid and CPR.

The Universal Precautions training shall be conducted in accordance with the most recent Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (OSHA). Bloodborne Pathogens standard (29 CFR 1910,1030) as amended pursuant to the *Needlestick Safety and Prevention Act* of 2000 and/or the Universal Precautions: An Educational Training For Child Care Providers developed by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and The Children's Hospital School Health Program located at www.cdphe.state.co.us/ps/hcc/univprecautions.pdf and shall focus on infants, toddlers and children. The instruction time this training shall require is a minimum of 90 minutes.

The contact information you provided will be added to our *Approved Training Vendor Directory*. The *Directory* is updated regularly and is included with the application materials that are sent to individuals who are seeking licensure as child care providers in Colorado. In addition, your contact information will be published in our website *Directory*: www.colorado.gov/CDHS/TrainingVendors.

Please note: The attestation must be completed and submitted each year by December 31st to remain on the *Directory*.
